Capital Credit Union Announces \$150,000 Donation to Mandan High School

BISMARCK, ND – Capital Credit Union today announced a donation of \$150,000 to the Braves Den school store, which will be in the new Mandan High School.

Run by the high school's DECA organization and marketing students, the Braves Den sells Mandan Braves apparel and accessories. The store provides the opportunity for students to learn about the life cycle of products which are researched, designed, created and sold by fellow students. Proceeds from the Braves Den directly impact marketing class projects, which generate more items for the store, and cover registration fees for marketing students to participate in professional development conferences.

"Supporting the communities where our members work and live is a fundamental part of who we are as a credit union," says President/CEO Vance Reinbold. "We are proud to be a part of the new Mandan High School with our sponsorship of the Braves Den."
